

## **TRIP PLANNING INVOLVING ADDITIONAL INDEPENDENT CARRIERS**

These regional shuttle carriers serve communities no one else does and provide access to other carriers at locations given below. They may have many additional flag or on call stops which may not appear in this website because the stop location is not clearly defined. Because they do not do interline ticketing with anyone, connections may not be guaranteed and separate arrangements must be made.

**Airporter Shuttle (SAS):** This carrier serving Western Washington State goes to Amtrak (ATK) King Street Station in Seattle near the Greyhound (GLI) Terminal which is also served by Olympic Bus Lines (OVT) and Northwestern Trailways (NWL).

**Bayrunner Shuttle (BRS):** This carrier serving Maryland goes to the Baltimore Greyhound (GLI) Terminal and is an Amtrak Thruways (ATK) carrier.

**Boston Express (BE):** This carrier serving NE Massachusetts and Southern New Hampshire goes to Boston South Station, a major intermodal hub served by all intercity train and bus carriers stopping in Boston.

**Bighorn Express (BHE):** This carrier serving Central and SE Utah stops at the Greyhound (GLI) station at Green River which is approximately 1/4 mile from the Amtrak (ATK) station. Their terminus in Salt Lake City is approximately 1 mile west of the major intercity ground transportation terminals used by all other carriers in Salt Lake City.

**Blue Rivers Transportation (BRT):** This carrier serving SE Nebraska will drop off and pick up at the Burlington Trailways (BTW)/ Black Hills Lines (BHL), Denver Coach Shuttle (DCS) and Amtrak (ATK) stations in Lincoln if requested.

**Caravan Airport Transportation (CART):** This carrier serving Eastern Oregon goes to Amtrak's (ATK) Portland Union Station across the street from the Portland Greyhound (GLI) Terminal. All intercity buses and trains serving Portland go to these two terminals.

**Central Oregon Breeze (COB):** This carrier serving West Central Oregon goes to Amtrak's (ATK) Portland Union Station across the street from the Portland Greyhound (GLI) Terminal. All intercity buses and trains serving Portland go to these two terminals. Central Oregon Breeze goes to Bend which is also served by Amtrak (ATK) Thruways, Porter Stage Lines (PSL), and Valley Retriever (VR).

**Concho Coach Lines (CCI):** This carrier serving West Central Texas serves Odessa and Midland which are also served by Greyhound (GLI) and All Aboard America (AAA).

**Curry Public Transit/Coastal Express (CPC):** This carrier serving Southern Coastal Oregon goes to Coos Bay, OR which is also served by Greyhound (GLI) interlining carrier, and Amtrak (ATK) Thruways provider Porter Stage Lines (PSL). This carrier also serves Smith River, CA which is also served by Greyhound (GLI) interlining carrier and Amtrak (ATK) Thruways Provider Southwest Point (TS).

**Dattco (DATT):** This carrier serving Connecticut and Eastern Massachusetts, also serves Hartford, New Haven and Boston, all served by a number of other carriers.

**Denver Coach Shuttle (DCS):** This carrier serving Eastern Wyoming, Eastern Colorado, and Nebraska goes near the Greyhound (GLI) Terminal and Amtrak (ATK) Station in Denver and Omaha. They can also connect with Blue Rivers Transp. (BRT) in Lincoln.

**Florida Shuttle Transportation (FST):** T These carriers together serve Georgia and Florida and stop in numerous communities served by Amtrak (ATK) Red Coach (RCU)/ Florida Express Bus (FEB): and Greyhound (GLI). Red Coach (RCU) also serves Atlanta which is served by Southeastern Stages (SES)

**Fronteras Del Norte (FDN):** This carrier serving California, Oregon and Washington goes to numerous communities served by Amtrak/ Amtrak Thruways (ATK), Greyhound (GLI) affiliated carriers and other Latino carriers such as Transportes Intercalifornias (TIC).

**La Cubana Omnibus (LCO):** This carrier serving Eastern Seaboard states from New York City to Florida goes to numerous communities served by Amtrak/ Amtrak Thruways (ATK), Greyhound (GLI) affiliated carriers and other independent carriers.

**Mountain Line Transit Authority (MLTA):** This carrier serving SW Pennsylvania, and Northern West Virginia goes to the Greyhound (GLI) Terminal in Pittsburgh which is near the Amtrak (ATK) station. All intercity ground transportation providers serving Pittsburgh go to one of these two terminals.

**New Town Bus Line (NTB):** This carrier serving North Dakota will carry passengers to the Amtrak (ATK) station in Minot and Grand Forks, the Jefferson Lines (JL) and Greyhound (GLI) station in Grand Forks and the Rimrock Trailways (RRT) station in Bismarck.

**Open Road Tours (ORT):** This carrier serving Central Arizona is an Amtrak Thruways (ATK) provider and goes near the Greyhound (GLI) stations in Flagstaff and Phoenix. They also go near the White Mountain Lines (WML) station in Phoenix.

**Oregon Coachways (OCW):** This carrier serving Northwestern Oregon is an Amtrak (ATK) Thruways provider and goes to Portland Union Station across the street from the Portland Greyhound (GLI) Terminal. All intercity buses and trains serving Portland go to these two terminals.

**Oregon Rural Van Service (ORVS):** This carrier serving East Central Oregon serves Bend also served by Amtrak Thruways (ATK) and Greyhound (GLI) interlining and other carriers.

**Rochester City Lines (RCL):** This carrier serving Southeastern Minnesota goes to Owatonna and Rochester which are served by Jefferson Lines (JL) and Winona which is served by Amtrak (ATK) and Jefferson Lines (JL).

**Redwood Coast Transit (RCT):** This carrier serving Northern Coastal California goes to Arcata, CA which is served by Amtrak (ATK) Thruways, Greyhound (GLI) and Redwood Transit (RT)/ Trinity Transportation (TT). They serve Smith River, CA which is also served by Greyhound (GLI) interlining carrier and Amtrak (ATK) Thruways Carrier Southwest Point (TS).

**Redwood Transit (RT)/ Trinity Transportation(TT):** These two carriers serving Northwestern California together provide a link between Arcata and Redding, CA with a transfer at Willow Creek, CA. Arcata is also served by Amtrak (ATK) Thruways, Greyhound (GLI), and Redwood Coast Transit (RCT). Redding is also served by Amtrak (ATK), Greyhound (GLI) and Sage Stage (SS).

**Rides MTD (RMTD):** This carrier serving Southeastern Illinois goes to Carbondale, IL which is served by Amtrak (ATK) and Greyhound (GLI).

**Southwest Transit (SWT):** This carrier serving Southwestern Oklahoma also goes to the Elk City Greyhound (GLI) station and the Lawton Jefferson Lines (JL) station.

**Transportes Intercalifornias (TIC):** This carrier serving Central and Southern California goes to numerous communities served by Amtrak/ Amtrak Thruways (ATK), Greyhound (GLI) affiliated carriers and other Latino carriers such as Fronteras Del Norte (FDN).

**Tufesa (TUF):** This carrier serving Southern Nevada and Arizona also serves Las Vegas, Phoenix and Tucson also served by Amtrak/ Amtrak Thruways (ATK) and Greyhound (GLI) affiliated carriers.

**Utah Trailways (UT):** This carrier serving Utah also serves Salt Lake City also served by Amtrak (ATK), Greyhound (GLI) and Salt Lake Express (SLE).

**West's Transportation (WT):** This carrier serving Eastern Coastal Maine goes to stations for CYR Bus Lines (CYR), Greyhound (GLI), and Amtrak (ATK) thruways provider Concord Coach Lines (CLI) in Bangor, ME.

**White Mountain Lines (WML):** This carrier serving Eastern Arizona goes near the Greyhound (GLI) stations in Phoenix and Mesa, AZ. They also go near the Amtrak Thruways (ATK) and Open Road Tours (ORT) station in Phoenix.

**Yankee Trails (YT):** This carrier serving Eastern Upstate New York and Bennington, VT stops by the Greyhound (GLI) station and near the Amtrak (ATK) station in Albany.
