

## **TRIP PLANNING INVOLVING COACH USA CARRIERS**

Because Coach USA carriers generally do not do interline ticketing with anyone including each other, connections are not guaranteed and separate arrangements must be made. Coach USA however serves many communities no one else does and can be used to access Amtrak, Greyhound and other regional carriers. Good transfer communities are listed below for each Coach USA carrier.

**Chenango Valley** - This Coach USA carrier serving Upstate New York currently does interline ticketing with Greyhound (GLI).  
Chenango Valley also serves Albany, NY which is served by Amtrak (ATK) and Peter Pan/ Bonanza Bus Lines (PPB).

**Coach USA Erie** - This carrier in Western New York serves Buffalo also served by Amtrak (ATK), Greyhound (GLI), Lake Front Lines (LFL), Fullington Trailways (FTW), New York Trailways (ANPT) and Coach USA Canada (CUSA). They also serve Hornell, NY which is served by Fullington Trailways (FTW) and Shortline (CUSA).

**Megabus** - This Coach USA carrier runs express service between major markets, but does serve a handful of communities with little or no other carrier options. Major city stops are usually adjacent to, or a short walking distance from terminals for Amtrak (ATK) and Greyhound (GLI) interlining carriers.

**Coach USA Canada** - This Coach USA carrier serves major markets in New York State while providing service between New York City and Toronto. Coach USA Canada also serves New York City Port Authority Terminal which is served by numerous bus companies and Buffalo also served by Amtrak (ATK), Greyhound (GLI), Lake Front Trailways (GLI), Fullington Trailways (FTW), New York Trailways (ANPT) and Coach USA Erie (CUSA).

**Shortline** - This carrier in Upstate New York and NE Pennsylvania currently does interline ticketing with Greyhound.  
Shortline also serves New York City Port Authority Terminal which is served by numerous bus companies and Hornell, NY which is served by Fullington Trailways (FTW) and Coach USA Erie (CUSA).

**Van Galder Bus Company** - This carrier serving NE Illinois and South Central Wisconsin provides thruways service for Amtrak.  
They serve Amtrak (ATK) Chicago Union Station which is only a few blocks from the Greyhound Terminal served by Greyhound (GLI), Lake Front Lines (LFL), Indian Trails (IT) and Burlington Trailways (BTW)  
Van Galder Bus Co. also serves Madison, WI which is served by Greyhound (GLI), Badger Bus Lines (BBL), and Jefferson Lines (JL).

**Olympia Trails** - These three Coach USA carriers are mostly airport shuttle services and rarely share terminals with other carriers. For those reasons, they should generally not be considered for trips that involve transfers.
